



Silver Mountain Private Event Policy and Price List

Silver Mountain offers private event space by advance reservation for groups up to 60 people. There are two seating location options:

- (1) The Grand Deck – covered deck overlooking the mountain view towards Half Moon Bay. This area can accommodate eight tables of 6. This is the perfect area for private tasting with table service. See below for more information.
- (2) The Vineyard Amphitheater – terraced area with benches, round tables, and a gazebo that can be used for live acoustic music. This area accommodates up to 60 guests. It offers a beautiful view of the Monterey Bay area. The vineyard amphitheater is perfect for groups. See below for more information.

Silver Mountain offers customizable private event options. The basic price structure is as follows: (prices are subject to tax)

Reserved Grand Deck table(s) – for groups up to 18 people

- Table service for tasting of 5 wines; \$25 per person tasting fee
- OR Bottle service - purchase regularly priced bottles of Silver Mountain wine.; \$35 per table.
- Up to three tables reserved for the group
- 2-hour reservation
- May bring own food and non-alcoholic drinks
- Absolutely NO outside alcohol permitted





Reserved Vineyard Amphitheater table(s) – for groups up to 18 people

- Bottle service – purchase regularly priced bottles of Silver Mountain wine. We will open them for you and supply you with wine glasses
- Reserve up to three tables at \$35 per table.
- 2-hour reservation
- May bring own food and non-alcoholic drinks
- Absolutely NO outside alcohol permitted

Customize your experience with these upgrades:

(1) Private tasting hosted by owner and winemaker, Jerold O’Brien. Includes viticultural history and wine education. \$100 for a group up to 18, or three tables.



(2) Order a charcuterie board or a catered meal from our caterer with one-week advance notice and approval. Prices to be determined by selection.

(3) Reserve a “dressed table” with linen tablecloths, napkins, flatware, dinnerware, water and wine glasses. \$10 per person.

(4) Add additional time to your reservation. \$100 per each additional hour

Silver Mountain has fantastic space to accommodate larger groups up to 60 people. We offer the following for our larger groups: (Inquire separately for pricing for Weddings and Receptions)

- \$500 event space fee
- Deposit – half of which is refundable up to 48 hours prior to event
- Staff to set up the tables in advance and clean up
- Choice of location – Grand Deck (48 people max) or Vineyard Amphitheater
- Reserved dressed tables with linen tablecloths, napkins, flatware, dinnerware, water and wine glasses
- 3-hour reservation
- \$25 per person attending
- Minimum purchase of Silver Mountain wines at the regular price. One bottle per every three guests.
- Corkage service offered by staff
- May bring your own food and non-alcoholic drinks
- Absolutely NO outside alcohol permitted

Customize your experience with these upgrades:

- (1) Order charcuterie boards or catered meals from our caterer with one-week advance notice and approval. Prices to be determined by selection.
- (2) Add additional time to your reservation. \$150 per each additional hour.
- (3) Arrange for live acoustic music in the Amphitheater, provided by yourself or contact us for suggestions and guidelines. \$100 per hour
- (4) Full use of kitchen: stove, oven, refrigerator/freezer, prep surfaces, sink, pots/pans. \$100 per hour

Availability

We will make every effort to accommodate your first choice of date and time. We are open for private events during the week and at times outside our normal tasting room hours. However, we are mindful that we want our guests to safely drive the mountain roads, so time limits may be set to provide that safety net. We are also mindful that we have neighbors nearby which also sets limits on noise levels (i.e. music).

Children and Pets Policy

We welcome well-behaved children who are supervised by an adult.

We welcome well-behaved dogs who are on a leash and supervised by an adult in the Vineyard Amphitheater or on the Grand Deck. Dogs are not allowed inside the tasting room.
